Why you should join the Colonial Athletic Boosters

Each school year TJ fields 46 teams in 17 sports at Freshman, JV, and Varsity levels. It takes about \$120,000 annually, beyond what Fairfax County provides, to fund TJ athletics. Colonial Athletic Boosters Membership, along with gate receipts (mostly football) and concessions (food and merchandise), are the primary sources for this funding.

Since 2000, the CAB has invested over \$600,000 in the TJ athletic program. Fairfax County pays only for coaches' salaries, utilities, and some transportation. Everything else -- the balls, the helmets, the uniforms, the nets, the scoreboards, the grass seed and fertilizer, the mowers, the professional development, and the trophies -- is paid for from funds that you help us raise each year! One check supports all VHSL sports at TJ and helps maintain and improve opportunities and facilities for all students.

Over the past several years, CAB also has funded new Nautilus fitness machines, a new TJ Stadium scoreboard, a new competition wrestling mat, Gym I scorer's table and team chairs, and audio and video systems for indoor and outdoor sports.

In the last ten years, the Boys and Girls at TJ who Run, Swim, and play Tennis won more than 40 District Championships!
